

Gibb River Road Project



The Gibb River Road provides access to the best series of gorges in Australia. It is also a far more direct route between Kununurra and Derby/Broome than going through Halls Creek and Fitzroy Crossing.

The road is mostly unsealed but can be travelled easily at 80 kmph. It is 650 km long. Sealing this road would cost \$195 million at \$300,000 per km. This would include sealing some of the roads into the gorges.

A bridge over the Durack River is estimated to cost \$18 million and the Pentecost River Bridge \$24 million.

The total cost of the Gibb River Road Project would be \$250 million.
