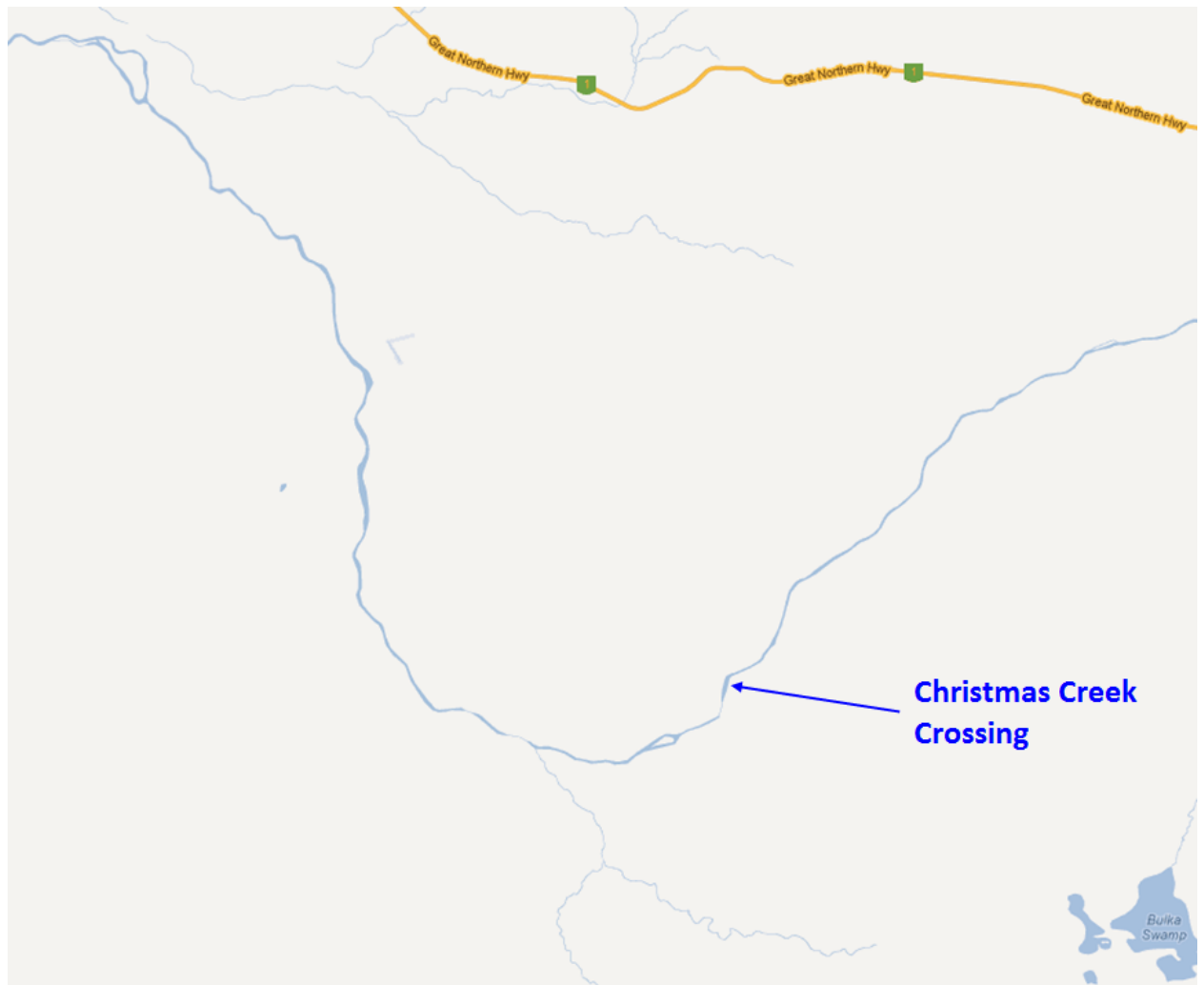


Christmas Creek Crossing



There is only one point of access for the large area southeast of Christmas Creek and that is the crossing at Bulka Station, which in turn is 120 km southeast of Fitzroy Crossing.

The crossing gets washed out each wet season. In the 2010 dry season, it was cut three times by floods.

This road cuts 300 km off the distance between Fitzroy Crossing and Billiluna, which otherwise goes almost to Halls Creek to pick up the Tanami Road.

A concrete causeway at Bulka Station would cost \$250,000. It would significantly lower the cost of commercial activities south of Christmas Creek.
